

2018 VICTORIAN CARAVAN CAMPING AND TOURING SUPERSHOW TWILIGHT PROMOTION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The promoter is Caravan Trade & Industries Association of Victoria T/A Caravan Industry Australia (Victorian Trades Division), Unit 8/88 Dynon Road, West Melbourne, VIC 3003, ABN: 67 413 472 774.
2. Entry is open only to Australian residents aged 18 or over, who are present at the Draw (defined below). Directors, officers, management and employees (and their immediate families) of the promoter, the agencies and companies associated with the Supershow are ineligible to participate.
3. **The competition commences on Friday, 23 February 2018 at 9.30am and ends on Friday, 23 February 2018 at 7:00pm (Competition Period).**
4. To enter, eligible entrants must, during the Competition Period:
 - a. attend the 2018 Victorian Caravan, Camping and Touring Supershow at Melbourne Showgrounds, Epsom Road, Ascot Vale VIC 3032 (**Supershow**);
 - b. receive a twilight entry ticket from gate staff upon their entry to the Supershow (subject to stocks remaining); and
 - c. provide any requested details and submit the perforated edge of the entry ticket into the entry barrel located near the stage under the pie at the Supershow. Entrants must retain the base of the entry ticket.
5. A maximum of one entry per person is permitted.
6. **Winners will be drawn at the stage under the pie at the Supershow on Friday, 23 February 2018 at 7.15pm (the Draw).** In order to be eligible to win a prize, entrants must be present at the Draw.
7. The eligible entrant whose entry ticket is drawn first will win the First Prize. The eligible entrant whose entry ticket is drawn second will win the Second Prize.
